**Englewood Construction Announces Completion of
Latest Alternative-Energy Project**

CHICAGO – Englewood Construction, a national commercial construction contractor based in Schiller Park, Ill., announced the completion of an alternative-energy equipment installation at Sloan Valve, a plumbing systems manufacturer in Franklin Park, Ill. The project included the installation of two wind turbines and a solar panel on the roof of Sloan Valve's headquarters.

The turbines and solar panel are part of an ongoing test by Aerotecture, a Chicago-based energy innovation company, to help determine which wind turbine and solar panel equipment work best in urban settings. A display that shows how much energy is being generated, used and saved by the turbines and solar panel is located near the employee entrance.

Englewood Construction installed one turbine over the front entrance and the second turbine over the employee entrance, near the energy display.

“As a member of the U.S. Green Building Council, we are proud to be a part of this test project, which will shape the future of energy-efficient building and design,” said Bill Di Santo, president of Englewood Construction. “We are committed to helping our clients reduce their carbon footprint through sustainable commercial construction.”

Recently, Englewood Construction also completed another green project, the build out of a Flip Flop Shops at Mandalay Place in Las Vegas. And last year the national general contractor implemented a paperless project management system that helped the firm go green and save green. Since its launch in the spring of 2008, Englewood Construction's paperless project management system has saved the firm more than \$150,000 in printing costs alone.
